# History of Gender Studies at the HU

# Focuses of the program

- □ Transdisciplinarity To reflect on perspectives from different disciplines (such as biology, history, philosophy, ethnology etc.)
- Critical The program encourages critical thinking regarding the production of knowledge, with a focus on institutions and power structures
- ☐ **Interdependency** To take an intersectional view of Gender with other forms of diversity (age, race, sex etc.)

#### Structure: MA Modules

#### Credits

- Students earn 4 credits per course
- One credit represents 25 hours of work
- You receive 1 credit for attendance and 3 credits for *Spezielle Arbeitsleistungen* e.g., essays, presentations, mini research projects, mini multimedia projects, designing and conducting one session of the course, and so on.
- Attention. Normally students at HU do not get a grade for every course. You always have to register for an exam to get a grade!





#### **Exams**

- Exams are called *Modulabschlussprüfungen* (MAPs)
- Types of exams (MAPs): a term paper, a portfolio, an oral or a written exam
- In most courses you will be able to do an exam (MAP), but not all of them. You can see which courses offer exams in our online catalogue, AGNES.

# Selecting Courses

- ☐ Where do I find the Gender Studies courses?
  - AGNES, our online course catalogue (KSBF, ZtG)
- ☐ How do I enroll in classes?
  - Check AGNES and see if you can register by clicking on "jetzt belegen/ abmelden"
  - Sometimes online registration is not possible and you have to attend the first session to register
  - Tip: Email the lecturer! (Their email addresses are in AGNES.)
- ☐ How do I register for an exam (MAP)?
  - Via the lecturers!!! (not via AGNES)





### Learning Agreements

#### Example of a <u>Learning Agreement</u> (LA)

- ☐ A LA is an individual study contract, which guarantees that the courses you study here are recognised at your home university
- ☐ It consists of 3 parts:
- 1st part choose courses before you arrive
- 2nd part used for if you change courses during your stay.
  Deadline: 6th week of semester (summer 31.5., fall 30.11.)
- 3rd part for recognition of courses after you return
- □ LA must be signed by: (1) student (2) home, and(3) guest university (Susanne Spintig)
- The complete and up-to-date Learning Agreement is the basis for the Transcript of Records





## Transcript of Records

- Who is in charge of these at the ZtG?
  - Erasmus advisor: Susanne Spintig
- Which documents are required?
  - Valid learning agreements (1,2,3)
  - Signed course <u>participation confirmation form</u>
     (<u>Lehrveranstaltungsnachweis</u>)
    One per module (with or without exams)
  - <u>Transcript of Records</u>, filled out in advance by the student
